Liberty Christian will offer a temporary virtual model to students that present a COVID-19 related health concern that would inhibit the student from attending class on campus in a traditional model. This virtual model is considered temporary and will not be utilized or allowed once the COVID-19 related health concern is removed or lessened to a point the student would be comfortable attending class on campus. Parents/Legal Guardian must submit a written request (*virtual application*) to the student's principal if they have a temporary COVID-19 concern to request the virtual model. Students exercising this request will be eligible for all extracurricular activities as per IHSA guidelines.
