Student Parking Policy

Liberty Christian High School permits licensed drivers to drive to school; however, driving to school is a privilege. Upon arrival to school, students are not permitted to remain in the parking lot. (Students are not permitted to exit the school building and go to the parking areas while school is in session) Parking outside the student parking lot may result in the loss of parking privileges and/or disciplinary action. Board policy requires that all students driving to school have a parking permit. Students must register vehicles in the office and obtain a parking permit. Students must attach a photocopy of their valid driver's license, registration, and a current copy of insurance to this application.

Student Driving Guidelines

Student drivers who wish to drive to school must abide by the following regulations:

- Drivers must submit current license, registration, and insurance card to the secondary office
- A valid parking sticker must be displayed
- Vehicles are to be parked in orderly fashion between the lines, and must not block other cars.
- Students may not visit or otherwise use their car during school hours
- Students who ride with other students to or from school must have their parent/guardian's written consent on file
- Students may not ride with other students on field trips
- Careless or reckless driving is prohibited and can result in the loss of driving privileges
- Students must enter the building once they arrive, and need to leave once they are to their cars at the end of the day.
- There is no expectation of privacy. Cars may be searched, just like a locker may be.
